If you notice any activity which appears to be operating in an unsafe manner please report this immediately using the QR code.

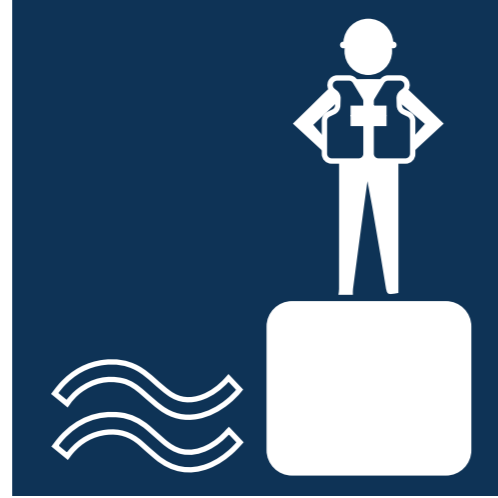

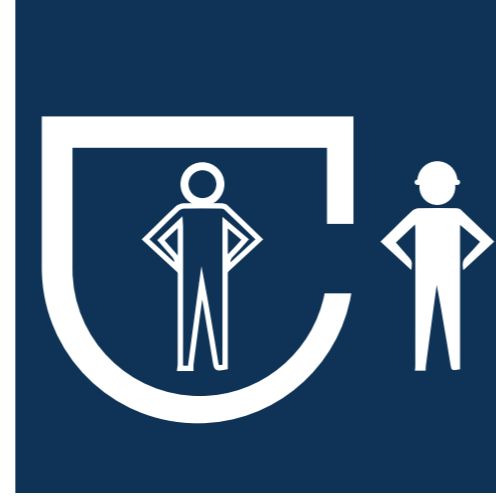

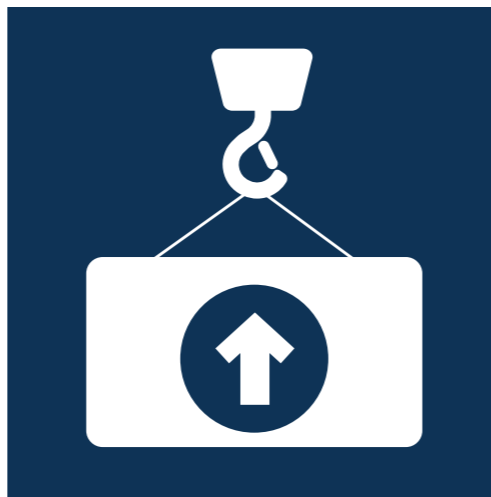

CONTROL OF WORK



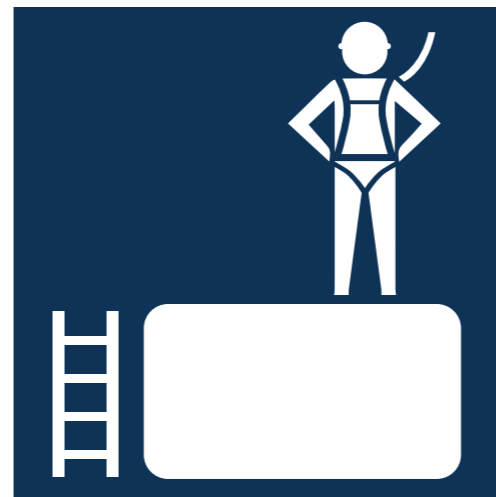
HAZARDS MUST BE IDENTIFIED
